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EDITORIAL POLICY OF THE JOURNAL «Bulletin of Abai KazNPU. Series of Physical and Mathematical sciences»

The journal "Bulletin of Abai Kazakh National Pedagogical University. Series: Physical and Mathematical Sciences" is published four times a year in an online (electronic) format according to the following established schedule: Issue No. 1 — by March 29 of the current year; Issue No. 2 — by June 29; the third issue — by September 29; and the fourth issue — by December 29.

Aims and Scope of the Journal

— the publication of scientific-methodological and practical materials in the fields of mathematics, physics, engineering, computer science, and informatization. The journal is a periodical publication designed for the prompt dissemination of the results of theoretical and applied research conducted by scientific schools and individual researchers, as well as articles addressing scientific issues in various areas of physics, mathematics, technical sciences, and the humanities (education).

Publication Terms

Publication is possible only if the journal's requirements are met.

The corresponding author (designated from the group of authors if there are two or more co-authors) must submit an electronic manuscript of the scientific article to the editorial board at least two months before the release date of the next journal issue. The recommended length of the article is no less than 5 and no more than 8 pages. In other cases, the article length must be agreed upon with the journal's editorial board. Illustrations, diagrams, and tables included in the article are counted in the total volume of the text.

The manuscript must be uploaded by the corresponding author through the electronic platform, including all metadata of the article and its authors. An article by the same author (prepared individually or in co-authorship) may be published in the journal no more than once during a calendar year.

At all stages of working with the manuscript, correspondence between the editorial board, the corresponding author, and the reviewers is carried out via the electronic (online) OJS platform, and in exceptional cases — via email.

The editorial board of the journal reviews manuscripts submitted by the author(s), organizes their peer review, and makes a decision on acceptance or rejection for publication within two months from the date the manuscript is submitted via the electronic platform.

The author(s) of a manuscript accepted for publication are required to pay the publication fee in accordance with the approved price list for publication in the scientific journals of Abai

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The manuscript must not have been previously published or submitted to other publications, must have a text originality of no less than 80% (the editorial board will check this using online plagiarism detection systems), and must receive positive reviews from the journal's experts. It must comply with the technical requirements. The editorial board reserves the right to request additional materials confirming the originality of the article.
